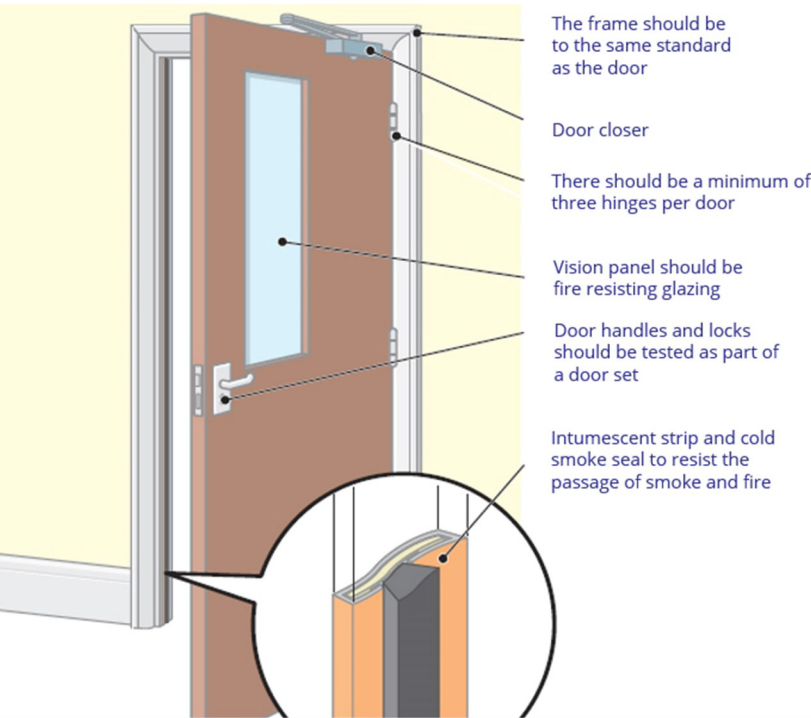


## Fire Door Inspections - Blocks of Flats



Are you complying with the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order (RRO) 2005 (as amended)?

As detailed in the Fire Safety (England) Regulations 2022 regular checks are required to identify issues early, ensuring the alarms, extinguishers, emergency lights and fire doors all function correctly.

Fireline Engineers as trained BRE fire door inspectors can do these for you.

We can carry out all necessary checks for you covering the content noted below. We will document all checks, update your fire log book and issue you with reports following each visit.

### Frequency of checks

#### Blocks of under 11m in height

**Six monthly:** Check all fire doors, other than flat entrance doors, to ensure that they are undamaged and effectively closing

**Annually:** Check all fire doors which includes flat entrance doors

#### Blocks of 11m in height and over

**Three monthly:** Check all fire doors, other than flat entrance doors, to ensure that they are undamaged and effectively closing

**Annually:** Check all fire doors which includes flat entrance doors

### What we will check:

- Door identification
- Frame & leaf
- Gaps & seals
- Hinges & closers
- Locks, handles and vision panels
- Signage

Our report will include an ID number for each door as well as an image. If you have a floor plan this can be used as part of the report to plot each door location.

We only carry out intrusive Fire Door Inspections following initial inspection and consultation with the customer.



- We can carry out a full fire door inspection and integrate it within your fire risk assessment document.
- The initial fire door inspection is more comprehensive, involving measurements and conformity checks.
